

# Rare and Unusual Bird Records of Westchester County

## by Michael Bochnik

This is an updated list by Michael Bochnik. It is a continuation of records compiled by Berna Lincoln, Tom Burke, John Askildsen, and others.

The purpose of this list is two-fold. One: have a record of all the vagrants, accidentals, and unusual sightings for Westchester County. Two: have a running tab of rare sightings to have an idea of changes and trends. For example, is a rare bird becoming rarer, less rare? Should a bird once considered rare, now be listed as occasional? This will also serve to estimate the rate of occurrences, for example, seen every other year, 10 years, every 50 years? The running list of rare sightings can also tell us when they are most likely to occur, spring vs. fall, September vs. October, etc.

The list follows the AOU Checklist order, last updated 2004 (45th Supplement)

Common year-round birds not listed (but see Interesting Reports of Common Species on last page).
