
73rd Bronx-Westchester Christmas Bird Count December 29, 1996


Sixty-two participants recorded 112 species and only 33,491 birds in the 73rd Bronx-Westchester Christmas Bird Count.


Highlights of this year's count included: an Orange-crowned Warbler in Yonkers; a singing Lincoln's Sparrow in Van Cortlandt Park; and two Great Egrets, one in Rye and the other in Pelham Bay Park. Each of these sightings was a third count record.



Other birds included: Red-necked Grebe off Glen Island; the return of a Monk Parakeet in the West Bronx; Three Northern Saw-whet Owls in Pelham Bay; House Wren in Riverdale Park; and a White-crowned Sparrow on Forest Ave. in Rye.

The weather played a large part in the low numbers this year. There was no sustained freeze before the count. Many individuals remained north and birds in the area were spread out as food was plentiful. Many bird feeders reported slow activity. The fog, and rain in the afternoon, decreased the numbers even further, especially for the ducks and gulls. Herring Gull hit an all time low of only 750! This is half the amount seen in the first year of the count: the 1924 count recorded fifteen hundred Herring Gulls. Only 68 Canvasbacks were seen: lowest since 1946. Totals for sedentary species such as Downy and Hairy Woodpeckers were average. Surprisingly Dark-eyed Junco numbers were above average.





There was only one new high count. Winter Wrens numbers exploded with 67 seen. It wiped out the previous high count of 25 from the previous year.

Carolina Wrens fared well after last year's harsh winter. The count tallied 45 Carolina Wrens: half of the last three year average.

The biggest surprise was that we missed Field Sparrow. We've only missed this the first year of the count - 1924!

Non-avian sightings included: Harbor Seal, Coyotes in Hartsdale and Woodlawn Cemetery, and deer tick activity.

Thanks to the 62 participants and the 30 who showed up for the compilation dinner.

Next year's count will be held Sunday, December 28,1997. Hope to see you there.
