82nd Bronx-Westchester Christmas Bird Count December 26, 2005

The Bronx-Westchester CBC has seen well over 220 different species.

The 82nd Bronx-Westchester Christmas Bird count held Monday, December 26 found 110 species and 39,630 birds.

The count was hampered by rain and fog for most of the morning; fortunately temperatures were in the mid 40's. Many bodies of fresh water remained mostly frozen.


Highlights included:

- * Three American Oystercatchers off Edgewater Point, Mamaroneck, second count record.
- * An unidentified swallow at Five Islands Park, New Rochelle.
- * Two White-winged Scoters, three Red-necked Grebes off Rye
- * Wilson's Snipe and fourteen Rusty Blackbirds in Van Cortlandt Park.
- * Three Chipping Sparrows, two in the Botanical Gardens and one in Riverdale.
- * And a count period Yellow-breasted Chat in Wave Hill which was closed for the count.
- * Other count week birds included Turkey Vulture, Eastern Phoebe, and Horned Lark

In an example of how things have changed; Peregrine Falcons set a new high count of seven breaking the old mark of 6 in 1936. Merlins tied a high count with four and we squeaked by with one American Kestrel. Who would have thought that one day peregrines and merlins would outnumber kestrels on a count?

There was also a new high count for Hooded Merganser (310). Black-capped Chickadees were abundant and fell just short of a high count.

House Finches continue their decline. There were only 155 birds, a 26-year low. Their high count was 1615 set in 1991.
